



Brief Guide & Time Line of the Movie

Here is the instruction sheet and timeline for Video 1 (Basic Course).

It's useful when you just want to check the drawing order or review a specific part.

		1.Introduction
		2. About Workshop
Prepare the stencils	(03:00)	3.Prepare the stencils you need depending on the version you want to draw. (Trace the red lines onto tracing paper.)
	(05:00)	4.Cut out the eye and nose areas on the cat stencil.
Paint White	(15:20)	5.Paint the entire Kent paper with white.
		6.Place the inner part of the cat stencil on the Kent paper. For a lucky cat or paw design, also position the arm stencil and tape it in place.
Paint background	(18:45)	7.Paint the background in your favorite color. (Darker tones work better around the cat's outline.)
Make Shadow	(25:00)	8.Add shadows under the chin and, if there's an arm, between the body and arm.
Ears	(27:20)	9.Cut out the triangular parts of the stencil to color inside the ears.
		10.Paint the inside of the ears in your favorite color, and use an eraser to draw patterns.
Eyes	(33:30)	11.Paint the eyes: – Start with a light base color. – Place the pupil stencil in the center and paint with a darker color. – Shade the upper part with black or another dark tone. – Use a fine eraser to add diagonal highlights (you can add a small circle highlight too).
Nose	(41:45)	12.Paint the nose in your favorite color
Mouth	(42:15)	13.Draw the mouth with a colored pencil.
Ribbon	(45:45)	14.For a lucky cat, add a shadow under the paw and draw lines between the fingers with a colored pencil. For paw pads, color each pad individually.
Hand	(48:00)	15.If adding a ribbon, place the stencil and apply the color.
Hairs	(49:45)	16.For a white cat, use a fine eraser to draw fur along the outline. For a colored cat, draw fur with a colored pencil of the same color.
Background	(55:20)	17.Finish by adding patterns to the background.
